

## Student Registration Policy

Please note the low Student Registration fees cover the food and beverage cost supplied to all delegates attending the conference. An incentive to register early is in place as is the norm with most conference registration fee practices.

To qualify as a Student you must meet two criteria:

1. Be registered into a FULL time curriculum at an accredited college or university (ie: 4-5 courses per semester; 2-3 semesters/year)
2. NOT be employed professionally and concurrently (ie: employment of 30+ hours per week that is considered at a professional level)

The purpose of our low student registration fee is to assist those that are economically challenged while engaged in academic excellence and still wish to learn and network with their emergency management mentors at the conference. This is a decision made by J&J Expositions to support students that genuinely need financial assistance as they pursue a business continuity career.

Therefore, applicants for a Student Registration fee will be denied if they are:

- Enrolled in an online course while also employed professionally full time
- Part-time students (1-3 course load) does not qualify for the Student rate

**Recent graduates** who are not yet employed in a professional capacity will be considered for the Student Registration fee.
